Therefore during the 2025 competitions, you will have to mention it on the starting-list , and strokes will be attributed accordingly. Important, don't forget it when you register, because we still have to prepare your score-cards.

For our winter meetings “Plaisirs d'hiver”, depending of the weather conditions, we will inform you of the possibilities.

Monsieur Picsou, our treasurer Marc, reports on the state of our finances, which are in line with previous years.

He announces that after eleven years at the same level, the membership fees should be adapted to the increase in our operating costs (website, domain, aperitifs, hall hire, etc.). We are now asking for 55€ (single) and 80€ (couple). 75€ for members with no connection to aviation.

The snugg fund's contribution to sponsorship has risen to 130€.
